SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO AYURVEDA/HOMOEOPATHY/ SIDDHA/UNANI/ MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to the Kerala Ayurveda/Homoeopathy/Siddha/Unani/Agriculture/Veterinary / Forestry/ Fisheries /Co-Operation & Banking/Climate change & Environmental Science/ B.Tech Biotechnology courses (Under Kerala Agricultural University) for the State Quota Seats have commenced.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses to be considered in the second phase of allotment, shall have to log on to their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the ‘**confirm**’ button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options/ courses/colleges till **05.10.2025 , 11.59 PM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**

Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to be considered in the second phase allotment.

The higher options of those candidates who got admission through first round allotment and who vacate the seats after option confirmation will not be considered for further allotments. But for those who do not confirm their

options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to **11.59 PM on 05.10.2025**, the second phase provisional allotment to Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on **06.10.2025**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) shown in the allotment memo, to the allotted colleges and should join the course/college allotted.

FEES

The details of fee for the Ayurveda / Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses, in various colleges is available in the website. Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not to pay the fee at

the time of admission. However, if such candidates are allotted under Management quota seats , they will have to remit the fee as shown in the allotment memo and they will not be eligible for any fee concession

Note

Candidates are instructed to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted. The allotment of those candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time will be lost and such candidates will not be considered for further centralised allotment for the courses in the medical/medical allied stream.
