NOTIFICATION FOR EXERCISING WEB OPTIONS FOR PHASE-III/MoP UP COUNSELLING FOR NON-SERVICE CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY QUOTA (CQ) SEATS OF POST-GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES AVAILABLE IN THE GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE NON-MINORITY AND MINORITY MEDICAL COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO Dr. NTRUHS AND SVIMS, TIRUPATI FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-25.

In continuation to this Office Notifications, dt.27-09-2024, 05-11-2024 & 06-01-2025 Dr.NTR UHS, Vijayawada hereby notifies the schedule for exercising Web Options for Phase-III/MoP UP of counselling for **Non-service candidates** for admissions into Competent Authority Quota (CQ) PG Medical Degree/Diploma courses available in the Government and Private Non-Minority and Minority Medical Colleges under Dr.NTR UHS and SVIMS, Tirupati for the academic year 2024-25.

- a) Seats available after Phase-II of Non-Service Vacant, Not Reported, Free Exit will be filled in this Phase of counselling.
- b) Vacant/Not Reported service seats after Phase-II reverted to Non-service will be filled in this phase of counselling.

All the eligible candidates (Non-service including (PwBD) whose names are in the Consolidated final Merit Position notified on 22-01-2025 in the University Website are only eligible to exercise web options as per the above dates and according to the Seat Matrix displayed on 22-11-2024, 13-12-2024 & 21-12-2024 in the website http://drntr.uhsap.in

UNIVERSITY FEE: Selected Candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking). Candidates already paid in Phase-I/Phase-II need not pay again.

TUITION FEE: The following is the Tuition fee structure for the academic year 2024-25 to be payable for the Competent Authority Quota seats in Private Un-aided Medical Colleges as per G.O.Rt.No.504, HM & FW (C1) Department, dated 06-08-2024 of Government of Andhra Pradesh subject to the outcome of the W.P.Nos.32975, 33162 & 35090 of 2022.

Instructions to Candidates:

- Seat Matrix is displayed in the University Website https://drntr.uhsap.in for information of the students. All the eligible candidates present in the Consolidated Final Merit list displayed on 22-01-2025 are eligible to opt for Phase-III/MoP UP.
- Candidates are advised to go through the Prospectus (placed in the University website on 27-09-2024) and the Government Orders on Rules of PG admissions available before exercising web options. Candidates are also advised to go through the details about "MRC" concept which is exemplified below:

Example:

- a) In a particular college MD(RD) seat is under "Open Category" in the seat matrix and a SC candidate is allotted that Open Category MD(RD) seat in Open Round Counselling of Phase-I as per his/her web options and NEET Rank merit order of the candidate. Now this candidate is shown as **Meritorious Reserved Candidate** (MRC).
- b) The same SC candidate has slided to MD (General Medicine) SC category seat in the same college or another college during the Category Round of Phase-I Counselling **conducted on the same day**, then that MD(RD) seat vacated by this MRC candidate shall be filled with the SC candidates only by merit amongst them.
- c) This type of MRC concept is to be followed for all BC/SC/ST categories in order to maintain 50 : 50 ratio of Open : Category Reservation

- As per G.O.Rt.No.513, HM&FW (C1) Dept., dt.08-08-2024 ordered "to continue Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada as a State wide Educational Institution by excluding the 36% of seats reserved and allocated to local candidates from the Osmania or Kakatiya University Local Areas (Telangana Area) under the 1974 Order. These seats shall be exclusively allocated to candidates from the state of Andhra Pradesh to comply with the requirements of Paragraph 6 of the 1974 Order read with Article 371 D of the Constitution of India. The 36% seats shall be distributed among the local candidates relating to both Andhra and Sri Venkateswara University Local Areas and can be filled by merit duly implementing the statutory reservations as applicable, to protect the interests of the students of Andhra Pradesh, until a fresh/modified Order is obtained from the Hon'ble President of India at the earliest opportunity."
- As per the year 2023-24 Notifications for Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling, candidates who participated in Stray/Special Stray rounds of CQ/MQ counselling conducted for the year 2023-24 and allotted seats but not reported/joined are debarred for admissions into CQ/MQ counselling for the year 2024-25 (List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
- As per G.O.Ms.No.67. dt.21-04-2017, the candidates who have discontinued the course from the academic year 2021-22 irrespective of their admission batch will be debarred for this academic year i.e., 2024-25(List of debarred candidates displayed on the University website).
- 6 Candidates opting for Medical Degree/Diploma courses are informed that, there is no limit of choices (number) for exercising web options. Candidates can exercise any number of options for any number of specialties and colleges available.
- Candidates are instructed to be careful while exercising options on the Web and take the print out of the saved options. Candidates are advised to exercise options in Courses and colleges in which they are genuinely interested. If they are not interested to join any specialty or college then they are advised not exercise options for the same.
- 8 a) The candidate can login at any point of time after submission of web options for rearranging the priority list before the cutoff date.
 - b) Options which are not saved will be saved automatically and will be considered for allotments.

- 9 The selected candidates have to login and to pay the University fee of ₹.23,600/- for downloading the Allotment Order by using Online payment method (Debit Card/Credit Card/Internet Banking) and report to the Principal of the Allotted College on or before the date specified in the allotment letter. University fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
- The selected candidates shall produce all the Original certificates, pay the Tuition fee, furnish necessary bonds etc., and complete the process of admission. If the candidate does not fulfil the criteria as per regulations to complete the admission process in the specified dates of admission, their admission will be cancelled automatically.
- The verification of original certificates will be conducted at the time of admission in the respective College and in case of any discrepancy, the Provisional allotment will be cancelled and action will be initiated. If the candidate slides to other college (i.e., affiliated colleges of Dr.NTR UHS) during subsequent Phases of counselling the tuition fee will be sent to the slided college by the concerned college where the amount is held.
- 12 | Eligibility for Exercising web options in Phase-III (Mop Up) Counselling

The following candidates are eligible:

- a) All the candidates who have been allotted and reported to the Phase-I/Phase-II seat.
- b) All the candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling.
- c) All candidates who have been allotted a seat in Phase-I/Phase-II
 - > but not reported/not joined at the allotted colleges.
 - > Joined but resigned from the allotted seat as per University Notifications for free exit.

However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II or resigned from the joined seat of Phase-I/Phase-II, then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Phase-III/Mop Up counselling.

- d) Phase-II joined/reported seat shall be the default last option.
- e) The Joined candidates who are holding a seat in Phase-I or Phase-II (Mop Up) Counselling are **not eligible** for Stray or any further rounds.
- f) Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling including Management Quota Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college.
- g) All the joined candidates of AIQ Round 3 counselling will be blocked for State Phase-III/Mop UP and Stray counselling of both CQ & MQ even if they have exercised web options.
- h) Candidates allotted/upgraded in CQ Phase-III irrespective of their reporting status will be blocked from participating in MQ Phase-III counselling, even though if they have exercised web options.
- i) MCC of DGHS will share the data of joined candidates in Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 counsellings with all the participating States. Similarly, the participating States will also share the data of joined candidates. Candidates who have joined up to Round 3 of MCC counselling and also the allotted candidates of Stray Vacancy round of MCC counselling will be filtered and weeded out before processing for Stray Vacancy round of counselling of AP State.
- j) Candidates allotted/upgraded under CQ in Phase-III shall not have any claim on the seat held in Phase-I/Phase-II either in CQ or MQ
- k) If a candidate is allotted a seat under CQ in Phase-III, they must compulsorily report. The previously held MQ seat from Phase-I/Phase-II will automatically be vacated, regardless of whether the candidate reports to the new CQ seat in Phase-III. The vacated MQ seat will be made available for allocation during MQ Phase-III Counselling.
- 1) Conversions will be done as per rules.

- 13 a) Candidates who are allotted a seat in this Phase-III (Mop Up) counselling must compulsorily report.
 - b) Candidates upgraded in Phase-III (Mop Up) shall not have any claim on the seat held/joined in Phase-I/Phase-II.
 - c) Candidates while giving options should note that the seats vacated by the candidates admitted in Phase-I/Phase-II counselling and slid to other college/course during this Phase-III (Mop Up) of counselling process (virtual vacancies) will be added & allotted simultaneously during this Phase of counselling itself.
- 14 | Eligibility for Exercising web options for Stray Counselling:
 - a) The candidates who have not been allotted in Phase 1, Phase 2, Phase 3 of counselling.
 - b) The candidates who have been allotted, but not joined in Phase 1, Phase 2 of State Quota and All India Quota are eligible to participate in this counselling. However, if a candidate has not joined/reported in the allotted seat of Phase-I/Phase-II then that particular seat shall not be available for that candidate to exercise web options in Stray Vacancy counselling.
 - c) Candidates not allotted or not holding any seat in Phase-I, Phase-II, and candidates not allotted any seat in Phase-III of (AIQ/State/Deemed) are only eligible for State Stray vacancy round counselling.

Not Eligible Candidates:

- a) The candidates who are holding PG Medical seat in Phase 1, Phase 2 and Phase 3 (Mop Up) of State Counselling are not eligible to participate in Stray round of counselling.
- b) The candidate who is holding a seat allotted in Round 1 & Round 2 and Round 3 in All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS).
- c) The candidates who have been allotted in stray round of All India Quota/Deemed universities(conducted by MCC/DGHS) are not eligible to participate in State Stray Round of counselling.
- d) Candidates allotted a seat in Phase III (Mop-Up) cannot participate in subsequent rounds of State Counselling, regardless of whether they report to the allotted college.
- As per G.O.Ms.No.67, dt.21-04-2017 in the final phase of final counselling, A candidate who exercised web options and joined in an allotted seat shall not be permitted to withdraw from the seat. In case any candidate withdraws from the allotted seat, the candidate shall be debarred for a period of three years for admission into Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses at the colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh besides payment of Rs. 3,54,000/- (including 18% GST).
- 16 The University fee and other fee once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
