A Student has to bear the cost of food of his own. A Student also has to pay the University Examination fees to the University of Dhaka for each professional examination and the Study Tour fee at the 4th year of MBBS course.

If a student fail to complete the MBBS course within 5 (five) years, then he has to pay tuition & accommodation fees monthly at the rate of that time up to completion of the course. There is absolutely no other additional or hidden cost.

After completion of the MBBS course, during internship training, a trainee will be entitled to an appropriate subsistence allowance or honorarium of BDT 15,000 (Fifteen thousand) taka per month.
