<u>KEAM -2024</u> <u>SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES</u> <u>FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION</u>

The activities related to the second phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses for the State Quota Seats available in Government Colleges and the seats available in Self financing Colleges has commenced.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the second phase allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the **'confirm'** button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can rearrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options Courses/colleges if applicable, till **18.09.2024**, **11.59 PM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to consider them in the second phase allotment. But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained. Those admitted candidates who wish to vacate the seats received through first phase allotment can vacate the seats on or before **18.09.2024**, **5.00 PM**, such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centralised allotment to MBBS/BDS courses.

Option registration facility will be available during this phase for Palakkad Institute of Medical Sciences, Walayar, as per the interim order of Hon'ble High court in WP(C) No. 29992/2024 and the annual fee (provisional) for the above college in General Category is ₹7,05,805/- and

for NRI Category ₹ 20,86,400/-, inclusive of NRI corpus fund. As per G.O. (Ms)No.55/2024/ H & FWD dated, 07-03- 2024 and Lr. No.S3/159/2022-Health dated 20-03-2024, the collection of ₹ 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh only) towards Corpus Fund from the NRI quota students shall be subjected to the final order of Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP(C)No(s) 9885- 88/2020. As the fees structure for the College for the academic year 2024-25 has not yet fixed, candidates who get allotment should pay the fee fixed as per the direction from Hon'ble High court in WP(C) No. 29992/2024. Further if the fee fixed by the ASC/Govt./Hon'ble Court Order for the academic year 2024-25 is higher than that of the provisionally paid fee, candidates are liable to pay the balance fee. The allotment/admission to the college is subjected to final outcome of writ petition of high court of Kerala / Government orders.

On the basis of options received up to **11.59 PM on 18.09.2024**, the second phase provisional allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on **19.09.2024**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of online payment or though any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the course/college allotted.

FEES

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2024-25 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who get allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2023-24 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if fee fixed Admission the to be by the Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2024-25 is going to be higher than that of 2023-24 for these colleges.

TOKEN FEES

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Selffinancing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (if applicable) as shown in the allotment memo to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and should take admission in the allotted college.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such students are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the token fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Note:

- 1. <u>Candidates are advised to confirm</u> options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
- 2. Those NRI candidates who have submitted expired or expiring Visa along with Online application and have submitted Self declaration from the sponsor can confirm options. If such candidates do not submit the original valid visa/acknowledgement on or before the last date fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for option submission to the Third Phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses, the allotment if any, received in NRI quota and the NRI status will be cancelled.
