Sub: Reduction of qualifying percentile for NEET-MDS, 2024.

Sir,

I am directed to say that this Ministry has decided to lower the qualifying cut-off percentile for NEET-MDS, 2024 by 21.692 percentile for each category (General, SC/ST/OBC and UR-PWD) in pursuance of DCI's MDS Regulations, 2017 and 2nd proviso in clause 7(1) of DCI's Master of Dental Surgery course (1st Amendment) Regulations, 2018. The qualifying percentiles for NEET-MDS, 2024, for the academic session 2024-25 now stand lowered as under:

S.No.	Category	Qualifying Percentile
1.	General (UR/EWS)	28.308
2.	SC/ST/OBC (Including PWD of SC/ST/OBC)	18.308
3.	UR-PWD	23.308

2. NBE is, therefore, directed to bring out revised results in accordance with the above lowered qualifying percentiles and MCC is requested to take appropriate action on priority basis.
