IV Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to M.D. / M.S. degree courses:

Candidates aspiring to join our postgraduate programs must have successfully cleared the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET PG-2024) conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences, New Delhi, on 11.08.2024, with results declared on 23.08.2024. Eligibility is contingent upon meeting the minimum percentile requirements as established by the National Medical Commission, New Delhi

Additionally, candidates must have completed a one-year MBBS internship by 15.08.2024. Indian citizens with foreign medical qualifications must have passed NEET-PG 2024 and the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (Screening Test) and be registered with the NMC or a State Medical Council. NEET-PG is mandatory even for foreign nationals seeking admission in medical courses in India.

Counseling Process:

In accordance with the PG Medical Education Regulations 2023, under clause 4.3 of common counselling, a centralized counseling process will be conducted for all PG courses based on the NEET-PG merit list by the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of the Directorate General of Health Services, New Delhi. All rounds of counseling for all seats will be held online.

Prospective students should register online at the MCC's official website (www.mcc.nic.in) and stay updated with the counseling schedule and related information. Upon receiving an online allotment order, candidates must report to the Chettinad Academy of Research and Education's University office to complete the application and reporting formalities, including payment of tuition and other fees for the academic year 2024-25, by the specified dates.

Failure to comply with these requirements will result in forfeiture of the admission offer. Candidates must also present all original certificates at the time of admission and are advised to retain sufficient photocopies for their records.

The amount of fee to be deducted in case the candidate resigns after counseling period / cutoff date:

Where any student applies for discontinuance, or without any application discontinues on his/her own, from the course to which he/she has been admitted to, for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/ remaining course period'.

No migration to other medical course during the course of study is permissible.

VIII General Information:

Admissions to Chettinad Hospital and Research Institute are subject to meeting all eligibility criteria set forth by the University and statutory bodies such as the National Medical Commission/Medical Council of India. Any submission of false information or forged documents will result in immediate cancellation of admission, which is irrevocable.

Eligibility and Admission Process:

- Appearance in NEET-NEET-PG 2024 does not confer any automatic rights to secure a Post graduate MD/MS/Post Graduate Diploma seat.
- Selection is based on meeting eligibility criteria, medical fitness, and other conditions as prescribed by the MCC of DGHS, National Medical Commission, and the University.
- Candidates with provisional allotment obtained from MCC of DGHS must submit all required original documents and pay tuition fees promptly to avoid delays in the admission process.

 Candidates should ensure that their MBBS degree is recognized as per provisions of the NMC Act, 2019 and the Post Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 2023. If it is found at any time that MBBS degree is not recognized, the candidature / result of the candidate shall be cancelled/ deemed to be cancelled.

Reporting and Documentation:

- Candidates must report in person at the specified date and time with all original certificates/documents.
- Failure to report or pay fees will result in the inability to proceed on the day of admission.
- Candidates who have deposited their original documents elsewhere must retrieve them; provisional certificates are not accepted.

University Regulations:

- Admitted students are subject to the University's rules regarding syllabus, examinations, fees, discipline, and fee refund policies.
- The University reserves the right to amend regulations in accordance with statutory council guidelines.
- Tuition and other fees for subsequent academic years must be paid by the due date, or enrollment may be terminated.

Attendance and Leave Policy:

- Students are advised against taking extended leaves during the course of study and should aim to complete their courses within three years.
- Leave due to illness or maternity will extend the study period by the same number of days for which maternity/paternal leave and total excess casual leave taken have been availed in 3 years.
- Re-admission after a study break requires a condonation order from the University and payment of prescribed fees.

<u>Training Requirements:</u>

- Students must serve as full-time residents and attend at least 80% of training to be eligible for examinations.
- Rigorous training and class attendance are essential for acquiring comprehensive medical knowledge.

Postgraduate Academic and Training Requirements:

To qualify for final examinations, postgraduate students must fulfill one of the following:

- Present a poster or deliver a podium presentation at a recognized conference in their specialty.
- Publish or have accepted for publication a research paper as the first author in a specialty journal.

Mandatory Courses:

- Research Methodology: Complete an online course in the first year, with certification required for final exam eligibility.
- Ethics: Complete a course in ethics, including Good Clinical Practices and Good Laboratory Practices, in the first year, with certification necessary for exam participation.
- Cardiac Life Support Skills: Complete Basic and Advanced Cardiac Life Support courses in the first year, with certification mandatory for exam eligibility.

These requirements are applicable to all postgraduate students and are integral to the eligibility criteria for final examinations.

<u>District Residency Programme:</u>

To integrate Postgraduate students into the healthcare services, participation in the District Residency Programme is mandatory for a period of 3 months, providing essential exposure to the District Health System and District Hospitals.

<u>No Migration</u>: No student admitted in PG courses shall be permitted migration to any other Medical institutions as per NMC Norms.

Postgraduate students must retain the date of birth as recorded on their 12th-grade mark sheet Any requests for Date of birth changes will not be entertained.by the university

Legal and Disciplinary Matters:

- All disputes related to this Prospectus/ information bulletin will be decided by the Vice Chancellor, whose decision is final.
- Legal jurisdiction for matters arising from this bulletin lies exclusively in Chennai.

Tamil Nadu Medical Council Directives:

- Other state Candidates pursuing postgraduate, should compulsorily register in Tamil Nadu Medical Council "within three months of admission"
- In case of failure to register within the prescribed time (3 Months) Rs.10,000/- would be levied as fine, in addition to the normal registration fees.

Ragging in any form is prohibited in the University Campus:

- The University enforces a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging, which is a criminal offense.
- Strict adherence to UGC and NMC/MCI anti-ragging regulations is mandatory, with penalties for violators.

The candidates are informed that during the time of original certificate verification in the counseling venue or at the time of admission if it is found that a candidate has been involved in impersonation/ suppression or misrepresentation of facts and produced falsified/bogus certificates by the candidates, his / her name from the admission list will be cancelled at any stage.

X For NRI / OCI / PIO / Foreign National Candidates:

The definition of NRI for admission to Deemed Universities shall be as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 22.08.2017 in WP No.689/2017.

Admission in MD/MS degree course under NRI quota for 2024-25 shall be based on the NEET PG 2024 qualification and shall come through DGHS counseling.

Please note that the tuition fee for NRI candidates should be remitted in US Dollar only.

Indian citizen or Overseas Citizen of India who have obtained their primary medical qualification from Medical Colleges outside India should have passed the screening test, qualified in NEET PG 2024 and Internship completion on or before 15.08.2024.

Foreign Medical Graduates are required to bring their FMGE Pass Certificate issued by NBEMS.

Registration with National Medical Commission / Medical Council of India / State Medical Council is mandatory with documentary proof.

Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Foreign Nationals will be considered only for NRI seats and not for Indian AIQ/Central/Deemed Paid seats.

Candidates who fall under the category NRI as per the direction / orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case (W.P. (C) No.689/2017- Consortium of Deemed

Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Anr. Vs. Union Of India & Ors.) dated 22.08.2017 are eligible for NRI category.

For NRI sponsored candidates, in addition to the above checklist **original** documents the following should be produced:

- **Original** Affidavit from the sponsorer that he / she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate duly notarized.
- Original Embassy Certificate complying the Income Tax Rules of the Sponsorer / Parents. (Certificate from the Consulate)
- Original Family tree notarized by the Tahsildar
- Original Relationship certificate issued by the Tahsildar of the concerned Taluk office
- Any other documents as prescribed by the MCC / NMC / Statutory bodies.

OCI/ PIO/ Foreign National candidates (whichever applicable)

- Nationality certificate
- Copy of passport of student duly self attested
- Certificate of Registration Overseas Citizen of India, if applicable
- Temporary registration for the duration of the PG course issued by the NMC.
- Registration certificate issued by the authority in his own country where the candidate obtained his/her basic medical qualification duly recognized.
