**SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO AYURVEDA/HOMOEEO/**  
**SIDDHA/UNANI/ MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES-2024**  
**FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION**

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to the Kerala Ayurveda/Homoeopathy/Siddha/Unani/Agriculture/Veterinary / Forestry/ Fisheries /Co-Operation & Banking/Climate change & Environmental Science/ B.Tech Biotechnology courses (Under Kerala Agricultural University) for the State Quota Seats has commenced.

**Online Option Confirmation is mandatory**

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses to be considered in the second phase of allotment, shall have to log on to their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the '**confirm**' button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options Courses/colleges till **02.10.2024, 11.59 PM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to be considered in the second phase allotment.

The higher options of those candidates who got admission through first round allotment and who vacate the seats after option confirmation will not be considered for further allotments. But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained.

On the basis of options received up to **11.59 PM on 02.10.2024** the second phase provisional allotment to Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses will be published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) on **03.10.2024**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) shown in the allotment memo, to the allotted colleges and should join the course/college allotted.

### **DETAILED SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT**

27.09.2024	Website opens for Online Option confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options for Ayurveda/ Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses.
02.10.2024, 11.59 PM	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement / deletion of options ends.
03.10.2024	Publication of Second Allotment (Provisional)
04.10.2024	Publication of Final Allotment
06.10.2024 to 09.10.2024, 4.00 PM	Time for Joining to the allotted colleges after paying required fees
09.10.2024, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall update the details of admitted candidates through OAMS.

### **FEES**

The details of fee for the Ayurveda / Homoeopathy /Siddha /Unani and Medical Allied courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2024-25 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing colleges, those candidates who got allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2023-24 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2024-25 is going to be higher than that of 2023-24 for these colleges.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having

benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not to pay the fee at the time of admission.

**Note:**

Candidates are instructed to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted. The allotment of those candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time will be lost and such candidates will not be considered for further centralised allotment for the courses in the medical/medical allied stream
